

ORDINANCE NO. 94-07-02

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING YARD SALES

AND GARAGE SALES

WHEREAS, the Village of Crainville has determined that in order to promote the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Crainville, regulations should be enacted concerning garage and yard sales.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAINVILLE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1.

Yard Sale And Garage Sale Defined. The publicly advertised offering of new or used merchandise for sale outside of an area zoned for business use.

SECTION 2.

A yard sale or garage sale may be conducted at any one residence within the Village no more than two (2) times in any calendar year. All garage sale and yard sale signs, notices or advertisements shall be removed within eight (8) hours of the termination of the yard sale or garage sale together with all nails, tacks or other materials used to post said signs or notices.

SECTION 3.

A yard sale or garage sale conducted within the Village of Crainville shall not be for a duration of more than seventy-two (72) hours.

SECTION 4.

Penalties For Violation. The owner of the premises where a yard sale is being conducted in violation of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined from TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) to FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) for each such offense and a separate offense shall be deemed committed for each day the offense or violation exists or is committed.

SECTION 5.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/1-2-4.
