ORDINANCE NO 12-04-01
ROAD CUT ORDINANCE
FOR THE VILLAGE OF CRAINVILLE

WHEREAS, It is necessary to protect the general public using the streets and alleys of the Village of Crainville, and ;

WHEREAS, It is necessary to insure that all streets and alleys disturbed during construction work will be properly restored following excavation work, and;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAINVILLE THAT THE AFOREMENTIONED ORDINANCE IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

At least 24 hours prior to making any street cut the person, persons or company performing the work must request and fully complete an application with the Village. If accepted by the Village a permit will be issued.

FEE:

A permit fee of \$250.00 will be charged payable by cashier's check or certified check.

BOND:

In addition to the permit, a performance bond must be posted in the amount of \$1,500.00 payable at the time the application is accepted payable by cashier's check or certified check. The bond will be refunded ninety (90) days after the work has been completed as provided herein and inspected by the Village. In the event the work is not performed as herein provided, the homeowner, person, persons and company performing the work shall be jointly and severely liable for any damage, directly or indirectly, caused by the street cut.

TERM OF PERMIT:

A permit shall be valid for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of issuance.

INGRESS AND EGRESS:

Any road cut made on any roadway with a single ingress and egress shall have an alternate access lane made and maintained until the trench is backfilled and accepted by the Village.

ROAD SPECIFICATION:

All work shall be strictly performed pursuant to the following specifications:

1. Streets and alleys with a dirt or stone surface:

The excavated material shall be removed and disposed of at a site acceptable to the Village. The excavation shall then be mechanically backfilled with compacted sand or compacted crushed stone. If the alley or street had a stone surface, the surface shall be replaced with a minimum of 12" of crushed stone within the excavated area, and the remainder of the disturbed area shall be resurfaced with a minimum of 6" of crushed stone.

2. Streets and alleys with oil and chip surface:

The excavated material shall be removed and disposed of at a site acceptable to the Village. The excavation shall then be mechanically backfilled with compacted sand or compacted crushed stone. The alley or street shall be replaced with a minimum of 12" of crushed stone within the excavated area, and the disturbed area shall be resurfaced with a three coat oil and chip (A-3) surface. At the Village's option, the cost of providing the oil and chip surface may be withheld from the bond before refunded.

3. Streets and Alleys with paved (concrete or bituminous concrete) surface:

The excavated material shall be removed and disposed of at a site acceptable to the Village. The excavation shall be mechanically backfilled with compacted sand or compacted crushed stone. The alley or street shall be replaced with a minimum of 12" of crushed stone within the excavated area, and the disturbed area shall be paved with seven (7) bag concrete mix, a minimum of eight (8) inches thick. Bituminous concrete (hot mix) shall not be used to pave any street cuts.

The concrete roadway shall be one (1) foot wider, on each side, than the excavated area.

COMPACTION:

All compaction shall be performed mechanically to 100% compaction. Compaction with use of a back-hoe or trac-hoe bucket shall not be acceptable.

INSPECTION:

A Village representative will inspect all street cuts on at least four stages. First, after the trench is excavated. Second, once one half of the backfilling is complete. Third, once the backfill is complete. Fourth, once the surface is complete. It is the responsibility of the person, persons or company performing the work to notify the Village when the work is to a stage for inspection. In the event the work is not inspected as herein provided, the bond shall be forfeited.

VIOLATIONS:

It is further provided that any violation of this Ordinance shall be a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, offenders shall be fined in an amount not to exceed \$500.00 and not less than \$500.00 each day the violation is committed or permitted to continue. Each day the violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such. In addition to the aforementioned fine, the homeowner, person, persons and company performing the work shall be jointly and severally liable for any damage, directly or indirectly, caused by the street cut.

MISCELLANEOUS:

All taps shall be inspected by the Village representative.

All taps into the Village sewer system will be done by an Illinois licensed plumber.

The Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet as provided by law.
