ORDINANCE NO. 99-05-04

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE BUSINESS USE

OF THE VILLAGE PARK

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Crainville, find it is in the best interests of the citizens of the Village of Crainville, that the use of the public park be regulated for the benefit of the public at large; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees find that use of the public park lands should be controlled as to business users, by permit.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Crainville as follows:

1. Business use Defined.

For the purposes of this Ordinance "business use" is hereby defined as any use of the public property which is in furtherance of the occupation work, or trade of any person or entity, including, but not limited to, the buying or selling of commodities or services. Babysitting

shall not be considered a business use unless the user is a daycare provider with five (5) or more children.

2. Business use prohibited.

The business use of the public park is hereby prohibited except by special permit to be issued by the Village of Crainville.

2. Permit.

Any person may apply for the special use of the Village Park for a purpose otherwise prohibited under this ordinance by applying for and obtaining a permit through the Village. The permit shall specify the exact nature of the use and shall be limited in duration to the time, purpose, and use of the park as specified in the permit. The Village President, or other authorized person may screen the applications and issue permits upon such terms, fees, and conditions as may be determined by such authorized person.

4. Penalty.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined in an amount not less than ten dollars (\$10.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00). Each day such violation is committed or permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such hereunder.

This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance NO.
