ORDINANCE NO. 99-06-01

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE COLLECTION  
OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE

WHEREAS, the President of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Crainville, find that it is in the best interests of the citizens of the Village of Crainville that the collection of garbage and refuse be regulated;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CRAINVILLE AS FOLLOWS:

1. DEFINITIONS: For the purpose of this Ordinance, unless otherwise indicated, the following definitions shall apply:

- ASHES: All ashes from wood, coal and coke and residue resulting from the combustion of any material or substance, and soot, cinders, slag and charcoal.
- GARBAGE: Refuse, organic matter, rejected or waste household food, offal, swill and carrion.
- REFUSE: All garbage, ashes and all other rejected matter, rubbish, dust and miscellaneous waste, but not including manure or discarded construction or building material, large tree limbs or brush.

2. ACCUMULATION PROHIBITED: The owner, occupant or lessee of any premises in the Village shall remove from said premises or otherwise dispose of all garbage, dead rodents, animals or fowls, ashes, tin cans, metal ware, broken glass, crockery, stoneware, manure and all refuse

and rubbish of every description whatsoever and shall keep said premises at all times free and clear of any accumulation of garbage, dead rodents, animals or fowls, ashes, tin cans, metal ware, broken glass, crockery, stoneware, manure and all refuse and rubbish of every description whatsoever. Dumping of rubbish on vacant property or on streets, alleys or other public places is prohibited.

3. ILLEGAL DEPOSITS: It shall be unlawful for any person to cast, place, sweep or deposit within the limits of the Village any garbage or other waste matter or rubbish in such a manner that it may be carried or deposited by the action of the sun, wind, rain or snow into or upon any street, sidewalk, alley, sewer, parkway or other public place, or into any occupied or unoccupied premises within the limits of the Village.

4. OFFENSIVE SUBSTANCES: No pile or deposit of manure, garbage, miscellaneous waste, or refuse of any kind whatsoever, nor accumulation of any offensive or nauseous substance shall be made within the limits of the Village, nor shall any person unload, discharge or put upon the right of way of any railroad, street, alley or public place within the Village, any manure, garbage, miscellaneous waste, refuse or offensive or nauseous substance, nor shall any vehicles loaded with or having upon them any such substance or substances, be allowed to remain or stand or park on or along any railroad, street, alley or other public place within the limits of the Village.

5. The Village may provide for the disposal of household garbage and other refuse, as above defined, by contract with a scavenger or disposal service.

6. LICENSE: It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in the business of collecting, hauling or transporting for hire for a fee, through the streets or public ways of the Village, any garbage, ashes, rubbish, yard waste or other waste materials without first obtaining a license to engage in such business.

7. AGREEMENT: The President and Board of Trustees shall have the authority to enter into an agreement with a person, firm, partnership, or corporation to provide the service for garbage and refuse collection referred to herein. Said agreement shall be on such terms and conditions as are agreed to by the President and Board of Trustees.

8. FEE: The fee for a license to collect, haul, or transport through the streets and public ways of the Village any garbage, ashes, rubbish, yard waste or other waste materials shall be in the amount of \$10. Said amount may be changed from time to time by motion or resolution of the Village Board. Such license shall be issued on an annual basis for a calendar year.

9. REVOCATION: Any license issued under the terms of this Ordinance may be revoked by the Village if said licensee fails to perform his duties under his contract with the Village, or violates any of the provisions of this Ordinance, or the laws of the State of Illinois.

10. COLLECTION SCHEDULE: The scavenger or disposal service shall make collections once a week on a day designated by agreement between the Village and the scavenger or disposal service. There shall be no change in the day of collection except upon written notification by said scavenger to the Village and upon notice to each owner, occupant or lessee receiving garbage disposal service under this ordinance and any contract in implementation thereof.

11. COLLECTION: Fees for the collection of garbage and waste materials shall be paid monthly to the Village. If service charges are not paid promptly, all municipal services for water and refuse collection shall cease and no more service shall be rendered to said delinquent until all charges are fully paid.

12. SCOPE: All garbage and other waste materials embraced within this Ordinance will be called for and disposed of by the licensee hereunder, and shall not be collected or disposed of, for hire, in any other manner, except as provided herein; and no garbage or waste material shall be allowed to accumulate on any property or premises within the Village for a period longer than the time between calls by said licensee.

13. YARD WASTE: Special provisions with respect to the collection of yard waste shall be subject to approval of the President and Board of Trustees. Any license granted hereunder shall also include the right to collect yard waste.

14. COMMINGLING OF WASTE PROHIBITED: No landscape waste, as defined by Public Act 85-1429 of the laws of the State of Illinois as now in effect or as may be amended

from time to time, or garbage and rubbish shall be placed in any bin for garbage and rubbish. No garbage and rubbish shall be placed in any containers for landscape waste.

15. PENALTY: Any person, firm, corporation, partnership or other legal entity violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) nor more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) for each offense.

16. It the intention of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Crainville that this Ordinance and every provision thereof shall be considered separable, and the invalidity of any section, clause, or provision of this Ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other portion of this Ordinance.

17. This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 99-06-01 of the ordinances of the Village of Crainville, Illinois, and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, recording, and publication in accordance with law.
